WALKING IN THE WORD

THE BOOK OF MARK



During October, we will be walking through the book of Mark. This one-month self-study will guide us as we read and meditate on God's Word. Mark uses the word "immediately" 39 times, giving us a sense of the shortness of Jesus' time on earth and the urgency of Jesus' message. We see the Son of Man on the move (1-10) and the Son of Man on the cross (11-16).

OBSERVATION

What does it say?

- What is the setting?
- What happens in the story?

INTERPRETATION

What does it mean?

- What might this text teach us about who Jesus was?
- How does this fit in with the greater story of the Bible?

APPLICATION

How to put it into practice?

- What am I going to do about what the passage says and means?
- How does this passage challenge my behavior or thinking?
