THE BOOK OF ACTS



During **May**, we will be walking through the book of **ACTS**. This one-month, self-study will guide us as we read and meditate on God's Word. The book of Acts picks up where the Gospel of Luke leaves off. It is the birth of the church and the spreading of the gospel. It includes stories of the Ascension, Pentecost, Peter, Stephen, and Paul. Luke's book is a travel adventure of the Apostle Paul and his missionary journeys. It ends with the gospel being taken to Rome.

- What might this text teach us about who Jesus was?
- How does this fit in with the greater story of the Bible?

APPLICATION

How to put it into practice?

- What am I going to do about what the passage says and means?
- How does this passage challenge my behavior or thinking?
