



During **August**, we will be walking through the books of **Romans and 1 & 2 Timothy**. This one-month, self-study will guide us as we read and meditate on God's Word. Paul's theme to the Romans is the basic gospel, God's plan of salvation and righteousness for all mankind, Jew and Gentile alike. 1 & 2 Timothy looks at false teachings, supervision of a growing church, appointment of qualified church leaders, and the welfare of the churches during the time of Nero. Paul encourages Timothy to persevere, keep preaching, and if necessary, suffer for it.

- What might this text teach us about who Jesus was?
- How does this fit in with the greater story of the Bible?
